Compensation Fund (CF), Unemployment Insurance Fund (UIF), Inspection and Enforcement Services (IES) and Public Employment Services (PES).

- Enquiries on injury claims
- Processing of Compensation benefits such as:
 - Medical invoice payments
 - Medical Refunds (traveling costs)
 - Authorisation of chronic medication
 - Authorisation of artificial devices
- Temporary Total Disablement (loss of salary)
- Permanent Disablement
- Fatal benefits (burial expenses, beneficiaries of the deceased)
- Investigation of unreported injuries and unregistered employers.
