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BACKGROUND

- Regulation 18.11 of DMR,2015 requires training of operators for Lifting machine
- The current National Code of Practice was published in 2015
- Amendment to meet QCTO requirements
- Standardize training of operators
- The new National Code of Practice was published on 24 November 2024

LIFTING MACHINES



LIFTING MACHINES



MAJOR CHANGES

- Alignment of the NCOP for training providers of lifting machine operators to QCTO requirements
- Mandate QCTO to quality assure training of LMO
- Alignment of entrance qualifications to NQF level descriptors
- Removal of repealed SAQA act
- Introduction of licensing body
- Introduction of skills programs

DEFINITIONS

- Authorized Body- mandated by NQF act
- Certificate of competence issued by authorized body
- Licensed operator previously called certificated operator
- Licensing body approved and mandated by the Chief inspector
- Non-credit bearing skills program
- Removed unit standard.

DUTIES OF AUTHORISED BODY

- Replaced quality assurance standing committee with internal accreditation committee
- Authorised body is mandated by the chief inspector

DUTIES OF ACCREDITED TRAINING PROVIDER

- Replaced SAQA Act with NQF Act
- Training providers must comply with authorized body accreditation criteria- removed ETQA criteria

DUTIES OF LICENSING BODY

- Issue license to a competent learner
- Assess competence of a learner
- DOEL and QCTO will audit licensing body
- DOEL.TETA and QCTO to approve the assessment process
- Licensing to be implemented within 1 year

FIELD OF ACTIVITY

- ETQA replaced by Authorised body

RECORDS OF RETENTION

- Learners records must be kept for 5years and not 3 years
- Authorised body to retain relevant records for 5 years.

TRAINING COURSE DURATION

- Ratio of learner to facilitator shall be 12:1
- Operators without valid license or temporary license shall not operate lifting machine

LICENSING(NEW)

- Operators found competent must be issued with a license
- Temporary license may be issued for 6 months where practical assessments is required
- Temporary license holders must operate under supervision of a person in possession of a valid license

RE-LICENSING

- Replaced recertification with re-lisencing, on expiry of a license.

ENTRANCE QUALIFICATION

- Learners must possess grade 9/AET 4 instead of grade 7
- Entrance qualification for mobile cranes and tower cranes GRADE 12 or NQF level 4 and not grade 10

REQUIREMENTS FOR AN ASSESSOR

- Certificate of competence
- 3 years experience
- Valid certification /license

CERTIFICATION

- Physical address of the training provider
- Full names and surname of the provider
- Skills program number and title
- Two authorizing signatures

LICENSE/CARRY CARD

- License identification number
- Temporary license will be valid for 6 months

RECOMMENDATIONS TO TRAINING PROVIDERS

- Accredited by QCTO and TETA until June 2027
- Apply for accreditation at QCTO
- Send accreditation letter to DOEL (R450)
- Comply to the NCOP
- Ensure all assessors/facilitators understand the NCOP

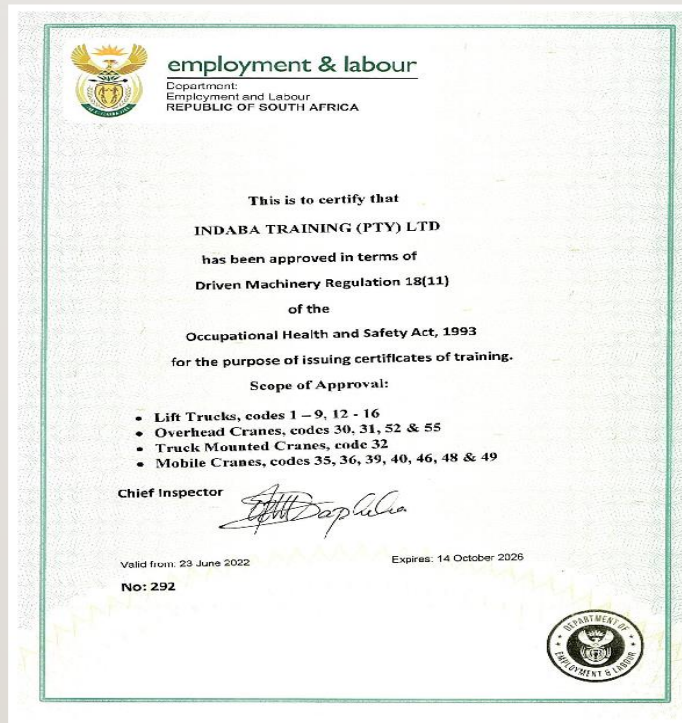
