Section 13(1)(i) of the National Qualifications Framework (NQF) Act, Act 67 of 2008

SAQA to:

- i. develop and implement policy and criteria for recognising a professional body and registering a professional designation for the purposes of this Act, after consultation with statutory and non-statutory bodies of expert practitioners in occupational fields and with the Quality Councils (QCs); and
- ii. recognise a professional body and register its professional designation if the criteria contemplated in subparagraph (i) have been met.



"Professional body" (SAQA Recognised)

means any body of expert practitioners in an occupational field, and includes an occupational body;



"Statutory Body" – (16 SAQA Recognised)

means an authority established by an Act of Parliament to provide for the registration and licensing of professionals and other categories in a specified occupation, trade or profession;

"Non-statutory Body" – (100 SAQA Recognised)

means a voluntary association established for the registration and conferring competence of professionals and other categories in a specified occupation, trade or profession:



"Professional Designation" (SAQA Registered)

means a title or status conferred by a professional body in recognition of a person's expertise and the right to practice in an occupational field.



Criteria - Recognition of Professional Body

- Legally constituted entity registered with CIPC
- ► Governed either MOI, statute, charter or a constitution
- Transformation policy that guides the constitution of the Board, staff and membership
- Necessary human resources, premises and financial resources
- Criteria to develop, award, monitor and revoke professional designations (RPL and CPD)
- ► All policies to adhere to POPIA, PAIA, PAJA Acts
- Database of individual members submitted to SAQA for uploading to the NLRD
- Code of Conduct and Disciplinary Procedure, to
- Protect the public interest in relation to services provided by its members



Criteria - Registration of Professional Designation

- Designation description with scope of work /authority
- Underlying Qualification Registered on the NQF (verified by SAQA)
- Workplace Experience / Experiential Learning / Practical Experience
- Competency Assessment
- Continuing Professional Development (CPD) Requirements
- Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)
- Professional Designation Progression Pathway



Purpose Professional Bodies and Designation

- Advancement of the NQF Registered Qualifications
- Promote the public understanding and trust in the profession
- Promote the profession as professional career
- Enable social responsibility, accountability and pride within the profession
- Protect the public from malpractice within the profession
- Promote Continued Professional Development (CPD) in the profession

Project and Construction Management Professions Act 48 of 2000 Sec 18.



18. Categories of Registration

- (1) The categories in which a person may register in the project and construction management professions are -
 - (a) professional, which is divided into -
 - (i) Professional Construction Manager; or
 - (ii) Professional Construction Project Manager; or
 - (b) candidate, which is divided into -
 - (i) Candidate Construction Manager; or
 - (ii) Candidate Construction Project Manager; or
 - (c) specified categories prescribed by the council.
- (2) A person may not practice in any of the categories contemplated in subsection (1), unless he or she is registered in that category.



Occupational Health and Safety Act of 1993 Construction Regulations 2014



5. Duties of Client

- (7) An agent contemplated in subregulations (5) and (6) must -
 - (b) be registered with a statutory body approved by the Chief Inspector as qualified to perform the required functions;

8. Management and Supervision of Construction Work

(6) No contractor may appoint a construction health and safety officer to assist in the control of health and safety related aspects on the site unless he or she is reasonably satisfied that the construction health and safety officer that he or she intends to appoint is registered with a statutory body approved by the Chief Inspector and has necessary competencies and resources to assist the contractor.
