



CALL FOR G20 SPONSORSHIP ON BEHALF OF THE SOUTH AFRICAN GOVERNMENT

South Africa will assume the Presidency of the Group of 20 (G20) on 1 December 2024.

The G20 is the premier forum for global economic cooperation and comprises 19 countries (Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, France, Germany, India, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, Republic of Korea, Mexico, Russia, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, Türkiye, United Kingdom, and United States), the European Union and the African Union.

The G20 South Africa Sponsorship Committee invites potential sponsors to partner with the government in sponsoring South Africa's G20.

The sponsorship should be in line with the sponsorship criteria to be outlined in the G20 Sponsorship Guidelines developed by the National Treasury, to be issued in November 2024.

The Call for Sponsorship opens on 1 November 2024 and closes on 31 March 2025.
