### QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS FOR THE TENDER BRIEFING SESSION FOR THE PROVISION OF SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF UNIFORM TENDER NUMBER: UIF7/25/26

**Question 1:** Clarity on the colours, as pictures are different from evaluating criteria. Which should be followed?

**Answer:** Bidders must refer to **Annexure A1**, as the colours are specified there. Other colours shown are for demonstration purposes only. Take guidance from Annexure A1, that where specific colours are indicated, and this is also stated on the pricing schedule.

**Question 2:** Regarding the colours, will it make any difference between navy blue and sky blue?

**Answer:** UIF is particular about the colours specified. Bidders are required to comply with the exact colours indicated.

**Question 3:** Do we have to bid/price each section or unit, or can we choose?

**Answer:** Procurements cover various sections. It is important to price for **all sections or units**.

**Question 4:** Quantities are provided for Year 1. How do we determine quantities for Years 2 and 3?

**Answer:** Estimated quantities are indicated, but immediate requirements are only for Year 1. Quantities for Years 2 and 3 are **also provided on estimation basis**, and for complete guidance, all the required quantities are stipulated in the Annexure A1 and the pricing schedule.

### ETENDERS QUESTIONS

**Question 1:**

Please give clearance on the following: Page 9, Table 2: section 4; should the audited financial statement be submitted with a proposal or that will only be requested from the successful bidder as stated on 15.6 page 18.

**Answer:** Yes, the audited financial statements should be submitted with a proposal.

**Question 2:** Page 16, 15.5: Designated sector: What is expected from the bidder on that requirement?

**Answer:** Designated Sectors are specific industries or market segments that have been officially identified as key areas where local economic participation is encouraged. In these sectors, goods and services are required to meet a **minimum percentage of local content**, and provide proof that the goods are manufactured locally.

### **Question 3**

Pricing Schedule, estimated quantities for year 2 and 3: Who should estimate the quantities? I see others are NIL which is clear, what about the quantities where nothing is written?

**Answer:** Where nothing is written/indicated those MUST BE treated as NIL
